

Wastewater System Operator – Second Shift

The Jackson County Water & Sewerage Authority (“Authority”) is seeking a full-time Wastewater System Operator in the Wastewater Services Department for second shift.

The Wastewater Operator is responsible for operating, monitoring, and maintaining wastewater treatment facilities to ensure compliance with environmental regulations and safe, efficient plant performance. This role requires technical expertise, attention to detail, and the ability to work independently during evening hours. (3:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.).

This is a skilled technical job requiring extensive knowledge of wastewater treatment involving the efficient operation of the Authority’s wastewater collection system and treatment facility. A High School Diploma or GED is required. A Class 3 Georgia Wastewater Treatment Plant license and one year experience in the field of wastewater treatment plant operations is preferred. Applicant must possess a valid Georgia Driver's License and have a satisfactory Motor Vehicle Record. The incumbent must submit to a comprehensive criminal background check and pass a pre-employment drug screening.
